**SUMMARY:** The position is responsible for supporting NMFWRI's ecological monitoring and restoration activities on public and private lands throughout New Mexico, Arizona, and Colorado. Activities are related to all phases of restoration from research and planning through project implementation and capacity building.

### DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform field measurements of forest resources and ecological indicators, including data recording and quality assurance. Work is often performed in remote locations over difficult terrain.
- Perform computer entry of field data.
- Generate summary reports of field data.
- Perform field mapping of project sites using Global Positioning System and Geographic Information Systems technologies.
- Assist NMFWRI staff and NMHU faculty in conducting training related to forest measurement, treatment, and analysis techniques.
- Perform routine cleaning and maintenance of NMFWRI equipment.
- Participate in the accomplishment of forest and watershed restoration treatments.
- Maintain regular attendance.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
