**Duties:**

Work directly with local farmers, growers, producers on their farms, ranches, and gardens and assist with all aspects of production and harvest of fruits, vegetables, grain, fodder products, livestock and poultry production.

Assist with weed and pest management on farms.

Assist in water management with drip and flood/furrow irrigation systems.

Monitor soil and water quality and conditions on local farms.

Keep organized records of production source information including locations, production types and methods.

Assist Tri-County Farmers' Market Manager with weekly setup and organization of market including:

- Collecting Market fees and forms from farmers and discuss Market Rules with farmers.
- Distribute WIC forms and go over WIC regulations with farmers.
- Assist with setup and take down of Market signage and preparation of Market site.
- Assist farmers with their booths setup.
- Assist and operate the Market stand including: sales of merchandise, answer questions, and distribute seasonal market information to visitors.
- Assist farmers at their booths.

Conduct weekly data collection of date, source origin, type, and quantity of market produce brought from local farms to the Tri-County Farmers' Market.

Conduct weekly visitor count and customer surveys.
