SUMMARY:

Students will be assigned tasks and assist Dr. Sinclair with GIS/GPS, historical and cultural mapping of the San Antonio de Cleveland Acequia.

Primary assignment for Students:

Under the supervisions of Dr. Sinclair, students will be charged with creating an overlay of maps that chart the course of the San Antonio de Cleveland Acequia and laterals. The maps will incorporate geographic, geologic, cultural and historical features and be presented in a user friendly format providing a record for the Acequia Association.

Students must have access to their own transportation and be able to travel to the Mora Valley in order to conduct this assignment. Students must also have access to computers (no computer access or office workspace is provided) and be proficient in mapping techniques including GIS?GPS. Dr. Sinclair will advise on creating the maps.

Creating the maps will include walking in rough terrain, climbing through fences, respect for private property and good communication with parcientes. Spanish speaking is preferred but not required.

- Upper-level Forestry/Natural Resource Management/ Environmental Science/ History/ Geography students preferred
- 1- 2 students needed for this project
- Students should be self-motivated and able to work in the field unsupervised
- Students should be task-oriented and able to complete this plan within the given timeframe
- Students should be able to work productively as cohorts.
- Students will be doing fieldwork and office work on their own, and will check in with Dr. Sinclair to report progress and discuss details.
- Students will be required to have access to high speed internet and check in with Dr. Sinclair via Skype.
