

Possible scholarships/internships coming up:

1. Minority awards program Smithsonian: to increase minority participation in Smithsonian scholarly programs:

This program is designed to provide undergraduate and beginning graduate students the opportunity to learn more about the Smithsonian and their academic fields through direct experience in research or museum-related internship projects under the supervision of research and professional staff members. Internships and Visiting Student appointments are full time (40 hours week) for ten weeks during the summer, fall or spring. Stipends are \$550 per week, with additional travel allowances offered in some cases and a small research allowance for Visiting Students. Must be U.S. Citizens or U.S. permanent residents.

Smithsonian fields of research include:

Animal behavior, ecology, environmental science, including an emphasis on the tropics
Anthropology, including archeology
Astrophysics and astronomy
Earth sciences and paleobiology
Evolutionary and systematic biology
History of science and technology
History of art, especially American, contemporary, African, Asian art, twentieth century
American crafts, and decorative arts
Social and cultural history of the United States
Folklife

Should be currently engaged in undergraduate or graduate study, and an overall GPA of 3.0.

2. Alice T. Schafer Mathematics Prize for excellence in Mathematics by an Undergraduate Woman

Must be an undergraduate by October 1, 2011. The 2012 Schafer prize will be awarded at the Joint Mathematics Meetings in Boston, MA January 2012.

The letters of nomination should include but is not limited to, an evaluation of the nominee on the following criteria:

- Quality of performance in advanced mathematics courses and special programs
- Demonstration of real interest in mathematics
- Ability for independent work in mathematics
- Performance in mathematical competitions at local or national level, if any

With letter of nomination, please include a copy of transcripts and indicate undergraduate level. Additional supporting materials should be included with the nomination, if applicable. Must be U.S. Citizen.

3. Pueblo of Zuni Tribal Scholarship



Application for Spring Semester deadline is October 30, 2011. Required documents:

Must complete FAFSA

Completed tribal scholarship application

Tribal census card – to verify legal Tribal enrollment

Official high school transcript for entering freshmen or Official College transcripts for continuing college students.

Letter of admissions – undergraduate students must be officially and fully admitted to a postsecondary institution. Enrollment verification will be requested from students who have already submitted a Letter of Admissions.

Student Aid Report – SAR – copy must be provided, a student aid report if the result of your FAFSA application.

Indian Health Contract Form – complete Part A, IHS fills out Part B. Once completed, contract health services will fax to our office.

Privacy Statement Form –read and sign the enclosed form. This authorizes the program to have access to your records with the school.

Financial Need Analysis – the form must be submitted to the Financial Aid Office of the postsecondary institution which you will be attending. The financial aid office must complete and return to our office before the October 30, 2011 deadline.

Do not fax application. Must be postmarked before or on due date. Deadline to submit all required documents listed above is:

October 30, 2011 for Spring Semester
April 30, 2012 for Summer Semester
June 30, 2012 for Fall Semester
